Students entering this contest must be enrolled at a NISOD or CCCSE member college in Spring 2026.

- Winners notified: March 13, 2026
- Winner acceptance due: March 20, 2026
- Prize presented and artwork revealed at NISOD conference: May 24, 2026

The winning artwork will be printed as black and white line work to be colored in by attendees at the 2027 conference, and may also be used in full color for advertising, promotions, etc.
